



Criw Celf
West & Mid Wales
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Criw Celf is an Arts Council of Wales project bringing together more able and talented students in the visual arts- with students ranging from ages 9-18. This is part of a national initiative to nurture young artistic talent in Wales. Working closely with schools, Criw Celf seeks to develop pupil's creative practice and knowledge of the Visual and Applied arts through a series of Masterclasses.

These Masterclasses are led by professional artist and designers, who offer a wider investigation into visual arts practice- in addition to an insight of future possibilities regarding creative and academic courses. The outcomes are then showcased in an end of project exhibition, which celebrate the portfolio of work created throughout the course. There will also be invitations to visit other exhibitions wider afield, in addition to artist studios, talks and university fine art departments.

Criw Celf is a national project which is coordinated in various regions across Wales. Two of these are Criw Celf West, and Criw Celf Mid which deliver the programme across the west Wales and mid Wales regions. Within these regions are galleries and cultural organizations, who work with their own network of partners to carry out the project. Criw Celf is made up of different strands for each age group; Criw Celf Primary (school years 5-6), Criw Celf Secondary (school years 7-9), Portfolio (students studying at GCSE) and Raising the Bar (students studying at AS/A Level and F/E).

- Attend 5 Masterclasses @ Carmarthen School of Art Jobs Well Road Campus (Still or Life Drawing, Painting, Jewellery, Ceramics, Surface Print and Pattern)
- Partake in an educational visit
- Exhibit work in an end of year public exhibition

Gorllewin a Chanolbarth Cymru
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Prosiect gan Gyngor Celfyddydau Cymru yw Criw Celf sydd yn dod â myfyrwyr mwy galluog a thalentog at ei gilydd yn y celfyddydau gweledol - gyda myfyrwyr yn amrywio o 9-18 oed. Mae'n rhan o fenter genedlaethol i feithrin talent artistig ifanc yng Nghymru. Wrth weithio'n agos gydag ysgolion, mae Criw Celf yn ceisio datblygu ymarfer creadigol disgybl a'i wybodaeth am gelfyddydau Gweledol a Chymhwysol drwy gyfres o Ddosbarthiadau Meistr.

Caiff y Dosbarthiadau Meistr hyn eu harwain gan artistiaid a dylunwyr proffesiynol, ac maent yn cynnig ymchwiliad ehangach o ymarfer yn y celfyddydau gweledol - yn ogystal â rhoi cipolwg ar bosibiliadau i'r dyfodol o ran cyrsiau creadigol ac academaidd. Bydd y canlyniadau wedyn yn cael eu harddangos mewn arddangosfa ar ddiwedd y prosiect, sy'n dathlu'r portffolio o waith a gafodd ei greu yn ystod y cwrs. Bydd gwahoddiadau hefyd i ymweld ag arddangosfeydd ymhellach i ffwrdd, yn ogystal â stiwdios artistiaid, sgyrsiau ac adrannau celfyddyd gain prifysgolion.

Mae Criw Celf yn brosiect cenedlaethol sy'n cael ei gydlynw mewn gwahanol ranbarthau ar draws Cymru. Dau o'r rhain yw Criw Celf y Gorllewin, a Chriw Celf y Canolbarth sy'n cyflwyno'r rhaglen ar draws rhanbarthau gorllewin Cymru a chanolbarth Cymru. O fewn y rhanbarthau hyn mae galerïau a sefydliadau diwylliannol, sy'n gweithio gyda'u rhwydwaith o bartneriaid nhw eu hunain i wireddu'r prosiect. Mae Criw Celf wedi ei lunio o wahanol adrannau ar gyfer pob grŵp oedran: Criw Celf Cynradd (blynyddoedd ysgol 5-6), Criw Celf Uwchradd (blynyddoedd ysgol 7-9), Portffolio (myfyrwys sy'n astudio TGAU) a Chodi'r Bar (myfyrwyr sy'n astudio lefel UG/Safon Uwch ac AB).
